Overview of 7th Grade Math :

- Ratios and Proportional Relationships
- The Number System
- Expressions and Equations
- Geometry
- Statistics and Probability

Expectations:

- Students will be in the room, seated and quiet when the bell rings.
- Students will respect their surroundings and fellow classmates.
- Students will be prepared for class. Have a pencil, notebook, and math textbook for every class hour. (additional items as told by the teacher throughout the year)
- Students will be responsible and keep track of notes and assignments and have projects handed in on time.
- Students will ask questions and come in for extra help if needed.

Attendance:

- If student knows he/she will be gone a certain date, he/she must get assignments before leaving and assignments are due when student returns back to school.
- If student misses because of sickness or other unexpected absence, then he/she will have two days for each day missed to get assignments handed in.
- If student is missing class for a school related function, then he/she is expected to get any notes and assignments prior to leaving, and hand in any work that is due that day. Any work handed in late due to school related functions will be graded by the late policy.

Grading:

- Students will be graded on a combination of daily work, journal participation, tests and projects.
- If a name is forgotten on an assignment a deduction of 2 points will be taken.
- If a student is caught cheating on any assignment they will earn a 0 on that assignment.

Late Work Policy:

- One day late, 10% off
- Two days late, 20% off
- Three days late, 30% off
- Four or more days late, 0 points
- Students who miss a test due to sickness will have two days to make up the test.
- Students who will miss a test due to school related functions, must meet with me to set up a time to take the test before they leave.
- Homework handed in late due to school related functions will be graded as late.
